➤ What to wear?

It will take about 15 minutes to plow your plot. There will be five sets of coaches and machinery operating simultaneously – so we will be able to accommodate your busy schedule.

➤ What happens after plowing?

- From approximately 11:45 to 12:30 there will be a light lunch served to our VIP & Media guests followed by a brief VIP & Media Plowing Awards presentation.
